



Distance Learning Discipline Procedures

EKA families,

It is imperative that our teachers see your students in the live sessions. This is for the protection of your student(s) as well as the protection of others. Please speak with your student(s) and help them to understand that this is a requirement during Distance Learning.

This is the disciplinary process we will be following with respect to this new rule:

If a student does not keep their camera on or refuses to put it on:

- 1.** First Instance - The teacher will private message them and remind them that this is a requirement.
- 2.** Second Instance - The teacher will email the parent and ask for help in reinforcing this rule with their student.
- 3.** Third Instance - The student will be removed from the specific live-stream class.
- 4.** If after the third instance, the student and their family meet with the teacher virtually and the student agrees to keep their video camera on, the teacher will allow them one last chance in their live-stream class.
- 5.** Fourth Instance - The student will be banned from attending that live stream class for the remainder of the quarter.

Students always have the ability to watch the play-back videos if they do not want to attend a live-stream class with these rules.

There is no mandatory attendance requirement for live-stream sessions.
